**Parking Registration & Stickers for Students:** You need to register with the main office any vehicle you will be parking at the school. Students must purchase a parking sticker, \$1 each, for each vehicle and must park in the designated student lots.

Student parking during the school day is in the large lot west of the high school. No student parking allowed in the lot between the high school and middle school.

Driving to school is a privilege... so be sure to get the right registration and park in the right spot.

Head to the main office to register any vehicle you might be driving to school – the parking stickers are just a dollar each.

And remember, you cannot park in the lot between the high school and middle school.

The student lot is the large lot west of the high school.
